sure that the summary gives a clear and concise description of the project.	Collecting 150 young European youths this cultural festival will take place in July 2008 as a week long activity. The goal is to experience and to promote cross-cultural dialog through two in themselves international tools: the international language Esperanto (the working language of the festival) and collaborative arts. The festival consists of two parts: During the first three days the participants will actively participate in workshops learning different ways of expressing and dealing with interculturality through creative arts, and during the last three days they will present the outcome of the workshops in the form of performances open to the participants and the inhabitants of Helsingør. Through displaying the dynamics of cross-cultural collaborations this approach also enables us to involve the locals and make them aware of the positive sides of cultural diversity. The central aims of the festival are: - to raise the awareness around cultural diversity using common human traits anchored in the creative arts (like music) within a neutral linguistic setting (Esperanto) - to promote tolerance within ar

international setting - to establish networks of young multicultural actors who can collaborate in future cross-cultural projects. These aims will be reached the non-formal education mainly by involving young Eurocitizens in collaborative performing arts. The Danish to

These aims will be reached through non-formal education mainly by involving young European citizens in collaborative performing arts. The Danish town Helsingør is a natural setting for this multicultural festival as Helsingør both provides an international flair (close to Sweden with Helsingborg as its Swedish twin) and a vibrant cultural atmosphere most famously known for being the home of Shakespeare's Hamlet. Inspired by this atmosphere the participants will interact in workshops focusing on various areas such as literature, music, dance, visual arts and theater. With art and Esperanto providing a both international and neutral medium of communication the participants facilitated by experts will develop projects built on cross-cultural dynamics to be presented at the end of the festival. Furthermore, the festival aims at including both the local inhabitants of Helsingør and the international Esperanto community. During the workshop days we plan to offer a workshop teaching songs from various countries thus enabling the participants to share their local culture with others. This workshop welcomes local inhabitants to participate in. The last three days of the festival will be open to the general public so they can experience the multicultural energy of the concerts, poetry readings, theater performances etc. The performances will also include guests like the Esperanto groups Hotel Desperado, Perdita generacio and Martin Wiese. Furthermore, to include people who cannot participate in the festival the performances and other events will be both podand videocasted. This enables us to share the festival with young people all over Europe and the world.

Please briefly describe the purpose of the meeting in your organisation's short and long-term programme:

TEJO's long term strategy is to offer meetings which illuminate aspects of TEJO's core issues. One of those issues, cross-cultural communication using the neutral medium Esperanto is the basis for this festival.

Preparation of the meeting (number of preparatory meetings, venue, number of participants and their country of residence, preparatory documents etc.):

The organizers will hold two preparatory meetings: in Malbork (Poland) December 2007 and in Copenhagen (Denmark) May 2008. Furthermore, virtual preparatory meetings will be held using chatrooms. These meetings will be documented by minutes from the meeting and a short report. The organizing committee currently consists of 7 persons residing in Denmark, Sweden, Switzerland, Bosnia-Herzegovina and France.

Follow-up to the meeting (other than a report):

Besides transmitting the festival through podcast and videocast during the actual meeting, the meeting will be followed up by the release of a DVD with material related to the meeting and by a web page to facilitate the network of cultural actors.

Please describe briefly your previous experience in organising activities of this type.

The organizers have vast experience organizing intercultural youth meetings ranging from 30 to 300 participants e.g a Studysession at the European Youth Center in Strasbourg, the International (Esperanto) Youth Congress (IJK), the World Esperanto Congress (UK), the Cultural Esperanto Festival (KEF), CISV summer village and Next Stop Sovjet.
